- . Two medical schools(Khartoum and Gezira) were accredited since then and the initial indicators of the positive impact of recognition were evident, a number of medical schools submitted their applications and self-study documents for starting the accreditation process by SMC, public debate on quality of medical education and the impact of accreditation on graduate outcome as well as support at higher legislative and executive levels were promising
